NOTE: The parish of those listed is CHEAM unless otherwise stated.

Paupers were examined to discover their last legal place of settlement which was gained by birth, £10 leasehold tenancy, apprenticeship, working in the parish for one year, serving as a parish officer for one year or paying parish rates. Women took their husband's settlement and children their father's. Bastards gained settlement in their place of birth until 1743; after that date they took their mother's settlement.
